
GIANPIERO CAVERO ALACRON (CHARLIE BROWN)




MIA ANDREATTA (PEPPERMINT PATTY)


CARLY PLAGEMAN (LUCY VAN PELT)








FABIAN TUDOR CARUNCHO (LINUS VAN PELT)






ALEX RODATOS (MALE UNDERSTUDY)


